APPLICATION PROCESS FOR AIRPORT IDs

Complete ID-1 Application Form

All parts of the form must be filled out and this document must be approved by an authorised signatory

**Complete & sign
Garda Vetting Invitation Form, Manager
Nomination Form
&
BSAT Form ID – 7**

**Applicant must produce 2 original forms of
identification including 1 photo ID & proof
of current address**

i.e. Passport, Driving Licence, Birth

These forms should be brought to the
Access & Identification Centre
(AIC) by the applicant where they
will be processed for Garda E-
Vetting

Note: You should allow at least 10 to 12
working days for processing.

Non Irish applicants & persons who have
worked/lived abroad for 6 months or more
(inc. travelling for long duration) must
provide a Police Certificate of Character
from their local National Police Force
indicating that they have no criminal
convictions and are of good character

Upon successful receipt of E-Vetting from An Garda Síochána & completion of all relevant training, the applicant will be approved to be issued with their ID card and may return to the AIC for collection. The applicant must produce the original of one of their identification documents
